The Missouri Basketball Coaches Association began its development in 1985 under the direction of Gary Filbert. Norm Stewart was the head basketball coach at the University of Missouri at that time, and Gary Filbert was on his staff as an assistant coach. Coach Stewart asked Gary Filbert, if he was allotted the time from his duties, could he start and maintain a state-wide Basketball Coaches Association? Gary did so, and was the Executive Director until his death in 2011.

The MBCA Mission is, and has been from the beginning, determined to "promote Basketball throughout the State of Missouri." We are doing this with over 1,500 members - they are provided professional liability insurance through the MBCA, along with the receiving awards and accolades for coaches, players and events. We also provide team rankings for all classifications, both girls and boys, weekly throughout the basketball season; we are the only organization in the state that provides this service.

<u>Gary Filbert Lifetime Achievement Award</u> – Highest MBCA Award given for meritorious service and contributions to Missouri Basketball.

<u>Gary Filbert Scholarship</u> – this is a one-time scholarship award of \$2,000.00 given to a son or daughter of a member coach who will be attending a Missouri University or College and is planning on majoring in Education.

MBCA Events -

• Our Basketball Clinic (held in September with over 900 coaches in attendance) - we consider this our most successful yearly event.

- The Norm Stewart Classic "48 Hours of High School Basketball" is our newest event, and we believe this is the only High School Basketball event of its kind in the country. The Classic consists of twenty-four varsity boys and girls games played over a period of 48 hours. We began on a Friday night at 6:00 pm playing a game every two hours / go around the clock, and finishing at 6:00 pm Sunday. The Classic is streamed on ESPN 3, with game announcers, Coach and Player interviews throughout the event / we are very excited that the Classic has been such a huge success. Non-profit partners, Coaches vs Cancer and Special Olympics Missouri benefited financially, along with the Missouri Basketball Coaches Association.
- **MBCA Celebration Weekend** is a two-day period in April where we conduct the following events:
 - Missouri Challenge Eight Girls and Eight Boys teams representing
 the eight regions of our state come together in one location to play a single
 elimination tournament Saturday and Sunday. The regional winner of each
 bracket will have their names inscribed on a trophy permanently housed in the
 MBCA section of the Missouri Sports Hall of Fame in Springfield, Mo.
 - 2. MBCA Hall of Fame enshrinement / held at the *Missouri Sports Hall of Fame* on Saturday.
 - 3. **MBCA Academic All-State and Awards Banquet** / held on Sunday with three hundred in attendance.
